USA Hockey Online Registration 2011 - 2012

All youth hockey players must register online individually with USA Hockey. In past seasons, associations were able to register all skaters, coaches and members; this is no longer the case.

You will be required to pay the \$30 USA Hockey membership fee and a \$10 WAHA fee individually and online before you are able to submit the registration to USA Hockey. Once you have registered, please save and print the confirmation page you receive. You will need to have the confirmation page with you when you register at the Pettit Center. If you do not have access to a computer you may complete the process at the Pettit Center at the time of registration.

To begin the registration process:

- Go to www.usahockey.com
- Click on the PLAYERS tab at the top of the page.
- Next choose the online registration tab.
- Follow the prompt
- Save and print the confirmation.
- Submit the confirmation page along with your Pettit Hockey registration forms.

Pettit Hockey Player Rules of Conduct

General Rules of Conduct:

- Keep locker rooms and all other areas of team/player use neat and tidy. All spaces are under the "leave no trace policy" and should be left clean and damage-free.
- Do not use or play with the elevator. The elevator should be for handicapped use only.
- No running, pushing, shoving or blocking in walkways or causing any disturbance while inside our outside the Pettit Center.
- No stick, puck or ball play in hallways or locker rooms. Sticks, pucks and balls may be used in a designated area under the supervision of an adult.
- Swearing and cussing will not be tolerated; in the locker room, on the bench, on the ice or the facility.
- Hockey is a privilege. Show respect for the game, the players, the coaches, the officials, and all Pettit Center users and Pettit Center staff at all times.

Penalty for Breaking General Rules of Conduct:

1. Contact parents and coach
2. One game suspension
3. Meeting with player, parents, coach, and hockey director

Major Rules of Conduct:

- No hazing or bullying of any team member or opponent. Hazing or bullying is defined as any action which intentionally creates mental or physical abuse, discomfort, embarrassment, ridicule, harassment, or fear in another person. This will apply to all direct/face-to-face contact and any other social situation.
- No foul or abusive language, no sexual innuendos or inappropriate sexual behavior/talk
- No hazing by means of social media, social networking, via the internet, mobile phones or any other communication means.
- No theft of any kind.
- No participation if under the influence of any controlled substance or alcohol.
- No tobacco use of any kind.
- No fighting or threatening other skaters, coaches, parents, staff or facility users.

Penalty for Breaking Major Rules of Conduct:

1. Notify parents and coach and impose a four week suspension from the team.
2. Suspended from the team for one half of a season with no refund.
3. Expulsion from program with no refund.

Please note that depending on the severity of any rule a legal statute may apply and may be subject to legal prosecution.
